The HKMA CME programme will be restructured to comprise a 3-year cycle focusing on Family Medicine with the core modules taking place at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital. The restructured programme entitled "Certificate Course on Family Medicine" is jointly organized by HKMA and the Department of Community and Family Medicine, CUHK and will kick-off on 18th January 2009. Members interested in taking this course are welcome to register directly with HKMA, or to enroll as part of the Diploma in Family Medicine (DFM) programme with CUHK's Department of Community & Family Medicine. Those HKMA registrants who have completed this Certificate course are encouraged to journey on with the DFM programme as their next level of CME. They will be exempted from taking the module on Principles and Practice of Family Medicine II (Clinical Family Medicine) of the DFM programme, which is equivalent to 4 out of the total 11 units required to get the quotable qualification of DFM (CUHK).
